The county has assumed responsibility to enforce Sedimentation Pollution Control laws that require anyone involved in land-disturbing activities to take special precautions to reduce soil erosion and prevent sedimentation. Applications/permits are required for any land disturbing activity over 100 sq. feet. For less than one acre a do-it-yourself sketch is sufficient but for more than an acre or where slopes exceed 16%, designs by a professional engineer or a landscape architect are required. Ms. Berry says she works with homeowners who only have small disturbances so that she doesn't have to inspect all of them.
